Signage Trail: Kurow Island and Wetland

In 2020 the Kurow Island and Wetland Groups joined forces proposing the Te Koharau Signage Project and were successful in receiving funding from Meridian Energy Power Up Fund for informational and photo panels, to be placed strategically around the Island and Wetland. The purpose of the panels is to inform and enlighten the visitor of our local history, the Waitaki Power System, a braided river and wetland and its ecosystem.

We are pleased to announce the project is completed - creating an informational trail - linking the Island to the wetland creating an education, recreational trail and tourist attraction to the area.

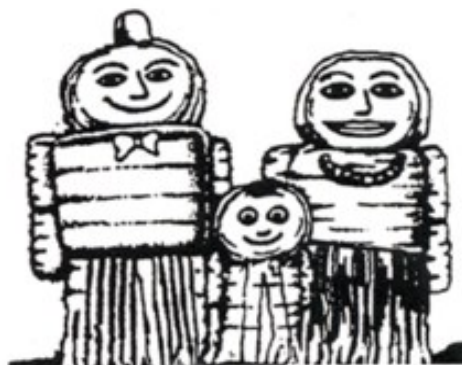

KUROW TRAILS REPORT

Kurow Hill

Another 'rescue' chair got carried up the hill last month (thanks Alistair and daughter Jody) to replace one that had been there for a few years. The old one had started to finally get tired of supporting peoples bottoms on it. There are about 8 places/chairs to rest on the way up the hill.

With the funding from the Waitaki District Councils Community Group Grants contestable fund of \$4000, we have bought the timber to be used for the replacement stairs at the start of the Hill. We are currently meeting with another community funder to fund the labour and machinery needed to build the stairs and 'fix' the 100 meters of the hill track.

Kurow Wetland

We have had a very busy few weeks in the wetland.

The entrance to the wetland by the highway is having a makeover with all the blackberry and oldmans beard and other scrubby weeds cut back and sprayed to open it up a lot more and as preparation for more native planting this season. Our Wetland Volunteers have been doing this.

Seven informational panels on birds/insects/plants and aquatics have been installed throughout the wetland. Thanks Nigel Grant Fencing for his voluntary work in the installation. There are many other people and sponsors involved in this big project in conjunction with the Kurow Island Group. There will be a separate article on this project in the Bugle soon.

The Kurow Wetland Planting day was a huge success. Thankyou to all the volunteers who helped out on this day. This was a collaboration between the Hakataramea Sustainability Collective (HSC), Waitaki Valley School, Waitaki Valley Community Nursery and Kurow Wetland. Over 400 plants were purchased from Matai Nurseries by HSC and donated to the Wetland. The natives were planted by the school children and caregivers.

The Kurow Wetland was successful in its funding application to the Meridian Power Up Community Fund. \$1200 was granted for the removal of problematic Willow limbs overhanging the track. Treekraft arborist will be undertaking this work in the next few weeks. Wetland will be closed on the days this happens.

Aoraki Tree and Scrub have started the spraying and poisoning of willows that are in the water. Wetland track will be closed on the days they are operating. Signage will be at the entrances/exits of wetland as well as on local Community social media pages.

If you are interested in native plants/wetlands or just want to be part of an outdoor community team offering some volunteer hours now and again then we will add you to the "friends of Kurow Wetland" group.

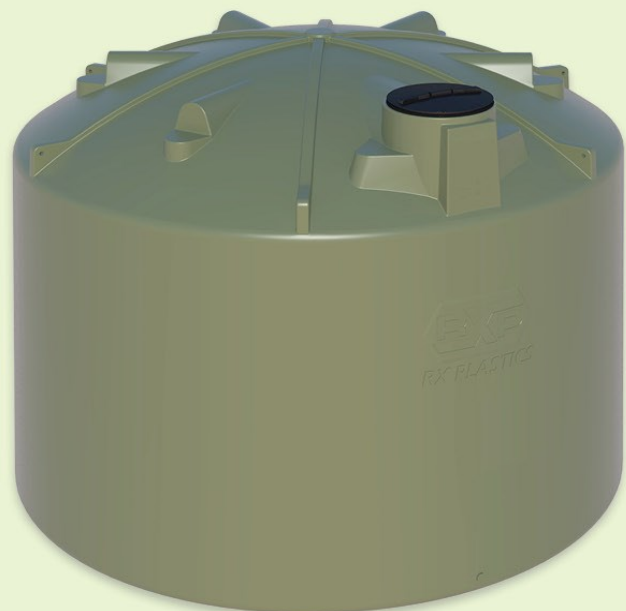

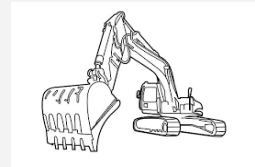
