Helping grow the country

English Part 2



Despite being recognised as the most influential writer in the English language, William Shakespeare did not know how to spell! Although he was taught Latin at school, spelling remained the individual's creation. For example, he had numerous ways of spelling his own name - Willm Shakp, William Shaksper, Wm Shakspe, William Shakspere and Willm Shakspere! Confusing if one does not know the man himself.

Shakespeare's birth date is unknown. We know he was baptised on April 26th 1564. For expediency's sake, it has been agreed that he may have been born on St George's Day, April 23rd 1564. He was the third of eight children, the oldest son of John Shakespeare – an alderman and successful glove-maker - and Mary Arden - the daughter of an affluent land-owning family. Little is known about his schooling, even less his school attendance. All we do know is that he did attend school! We know so few facts about Shakespeare that the use of the word 'probably' arises in many biographies and comments about his life.





At the age of 18 (November 27th 1582), Shakespeare married 26-year-old Ann Hathaway in a hastily arranged wedding. Six months later, their daughter Susanna arrived. Two years later, twins Hamnet (who died at 11 years of age, possibly from Bubonic Plague) and Judith followed. At this point, the Shakespeare family vanished. Little is known about their lives between 1585 and 1592. It is believed they lived in London where William began his theatrical career. Throughout his life, he wrote thirty-nine plays, 154 sonnets (14-line verse) and three long narrative poems. All these over a period of around twenty-eight years.

One of his more well-known sonnets:

Shall I compare thee to a summer's day? Thou art more lovely and more temperate: Rough winds do shake the darling buds of May, And summer's lease hath all too short a date: Sometime too hot the eye of heaven shines, And often is his gold complexion dimmed, And every fair from fair sometime declines, By chance, or nature's changing course untrimmed:

But thy eternal summer shall not fade, Nor lose possession of that fair thou ow'st, Nor shall death brag thou wander'st in his shade, When in eternal lines to time thou grow'st: So long as men can breathe, or eyes can see, So long lives this, and this gives life to thee.

Shakespeare used 17,677 different words in all his published writing. It is said that he invented around 1,700 words. However, some of these were commonly used during his life-time. He was the first to write them down.

With some suddenness, William Shakespeare passed away at the age of 52 years on April 23rd, 1616. Whilst his surviving daughters had families, none survived; thus, Shakespeare's line died with them. His works have been translated into every primary living language and performed more often than any other playwright. He remains the most influential writer in the English language.

The English alphabet has undergone many changes over the decades. Until 1835, it consisted of 27 letters, the ampersand (&) following 'Z'. Twenty-three letters came from Old English, with three - 'v', 'j' and 'w' - added during the 15th century with the arrival of the printing press. The world's most extended alphabet is Kymer (Cambodian), with 74 letters; the shortest is Rotokas (North Bougainville), with twelve letters and eleven different sounds.

And so we return to where we started. Poking fun at our language.
