Recently Kurow and Otematata had a boil water notice due to abnormal reading of E Coli in the towns supplies. This fortunately ended up being a good result in that the testing over numerous days since the abnormal reading came back with results being free of E Coli. The Council are continuing to investigate the cause of the failures.

This event identified some potential improvements that could be made to the communication methods. The Boil Water Notices were advertised on Facebook, the WDC website, radio stations and some consumers were contacted by phone, however a number of consumers still were not aware of the notice until later. A text message is likely a better way of spreading the word. Council already has a text system in place and will be using this in the future.

Meanwhile Summer still has a few months to allow us to enjoy our water activities and surrounds.



Kurow Hill Report

The Kurow Hill Track Viewpoint Accessibility Project that we applied funds for is complete.

The old steps have been replaced with new ones and the first 100 meters has been widened with a platform area for seating to go in at the first corner. This project has been made possible by the funding from Waitaki District Council Community Grant fund- \$11,500 Meridian Energy Power up fund- \$7814.11 Network Waitaki Powering our community fund. - \$1500 The work was undertaken by Recreation Construction (2021) Limited.

Track Status

The current steps are showing their 30 years of use & have become warm & steeper than standard DOC steps, in addition the track has worn to create a tunnel that increases the track difficulty. The photo below provides examples of this along the proposed track section for upgrade.

The track underneath each steps has worn with use since installed over 40 years ago to increase the height of the step to make it a more challenging climb & difficult step

The track has become washed out over time, exacerbated by users avoiding the high & worn steps

When traveling through Duntroon next time, consider a visit to the beautiful Saint Martin's Church.

Our 10ft storage container has been installed at the Kurow Wetland entrance. Its has made a huge difference for us volunteers who no longer have to cart everything back and forwards to the wetland in their car. Special thanks to Meridian Energy Power Up Community Fund for their contribution of \$6000 and Waitaki District Council Community Grant for their contribution to the container of \$1000.

An irrigation pump and system was installed in the new planting area alongside the Alps2Ocean trail to ensure a higher success rate for the new plantings. 


supporting the willow and weed removal from the wetland in preparation for the planting using Gary Hawkins Earthmoving Machinery for the digger work.
